## A Letter from the Head Coach



This will be my fourth year with the Lady Cards Varsity Soccer Team and I couldn't be more excited. I started coaching because I love the game!!

For me, the best part of coaching is developing relationships with the players and giving them a positive soccer experience. My goal in leading this team is to make sure that each player is becoming better while having fun. Also, my hope is to help these girls learn to care about themselves, their team, and their community.

We ended last season 3rd in league with a 9-5-2 record, and we just barely missed a berth to the State Tournament. We had many great games, such as our win against Horizon Christian (who otherwise went undefeated) and our win over Riverside during the 1st round of district playoffs. Last season, our team took 295 shots & had 37 goals on 15 assists. Our defense was also very solid, only allowing 154 shots and 20 goal for the season!

We had many key players who helped us to obtain such an amazing season, including 6 all-league nominees and several more who deserved an award. Last year's team was also awarded The Sportsmanship Award for our league. I consider this a huge compliment to our coaching staff, players, and fans. Keep it up!

This year from that outstanding team, we are returning 15 players and have added 14 new ones to our program. We are very excited about these numbers and, for the first time, will have a JV team. I know that each player on this team is very committed to improving their individual and team skills. This combination of young woman is playing beautiful soccer, and we are hoping to improve our record this year.

# **A Letter from the Athletic Director**

2010 - 2011 Corbett Sports Recap

With the significant influx of students through our Charter School, you might say we experienced some growing pains as we joined the 3A Lewis and Clark League for the 2010-11 school year.

**FALL:** Our **Football** team was competitive in non-league play but struggled to come up with a victory in our new 3A conference.

**Boys' Soccer** continued pace in the 3A/2A/1A Special District #2 by taking 2nd place in the conference. The 1st round state playoff trip to Pleasant Hill proved to be the last contest for our boys as they dropped the match by a score of 2-0.

**Girls' Soccer** came up one game shy of a state appearance as the Lady Cards lost to Portland Adventist in a playoff contest for 3A/2A/1A Special District #2.

The best finish for fall athletics came at the hands of our **Volleyball** team. Our Lady Cards did not miss a beat in the transition from 2A Northwest League to 3A Lewis and Clark League as they finished 2nd in conference standings and were ranked in the top 10 of the 3A Division for the majority of the season. A home, first round, state victory against Glide placed the Cardinals on the road to Lane Community College, where the final 8 teams in the state vied for the championship. Our Lady Cardinals finished with a 24-7 overall record and a 7th place finish at the state tournament.

Playing at home in front of an excited crowd, our **Middle School Volleyball** team captured the League Championship for the 3rd year in a row!

**WINTER:** Winter season brought more growing pains within the Lewis and Clark Conference. The **Girls' Basketball** team was considered young by many but had the potential to make some noise in our new league. Although our girls were competitive in league play, the end result saw our Lady Cards coming up short for a league playoff berth.

The **Boys' Basketball** team was very competitive in league play going 8-8 against Lewis and Clark opponents. The Cardinals made the league playoffs and hosted Catlin Gabel in the first round. After beating the Eagles in the first two league contests, the Cardinals ran into a buzz saw in the playoff game as Catlin Gabel ended our boys' season.

Our co-ed **Wrestling** team sent three representatives to the State Tournament and brought home one state champion as Cierra Williams took 1st place in the women's 154 lb. weight class!

The Corbett **Swimming Club** had a phenomenal run at the state title, sending 5 swimmers to the State Meet held at Mt. Hood Community College. Collin Eaton finished 1st in two events while fellow swimmer Isaac Hewitt had

one 1st place finish! Five young men accumulated 40 points and finished in 5th place overall. 1st place North Bend finished with a total of 45 points as the championship came down to the last event of the day. It was a great run for our boys!

**SPRING:** Spring season came with a lot of expectations for our **Softball** team. Sporting a great blend of pitching and catching and strength at every fielding position, the Lady Cards may have put their best overall team on the field in 2011. The Lewis and Clark League happened to be, however, one of the strongest at the 3A level. Our girls lost a tight playoff game to Valley Catholic, which surprisingly ended what many thought would be a deep run into the state playoffs.

The **Baseball** team struggled to get outside as one of the wettest springs on record allowed for 6 total outdoor practices. It was tough for our Cardinals to get any momentum going, particularly against our 3A opponents.

Our **Track and Field** team sent three representatives to the State Track Meet at Western Oregon in Monmouth and brought back a champion as Brandon Steinhauer took 1st place in the 3A shot put!

Expectations are extremely high as the 2011 fall season is upon us. Our Volleyball team is returning all of their starters from last year's state team, along with strong support players. Anything less than a repeat state appearance will be a disappointment to these young ladies and their Head Coach Angela Davis.

Football comes in under the direction of new Head Coach Lance Lovitt. A lot of athleticism along with a new direction in coaching will surprise quite a few people this year. First step is making the league playoffs. Coach Lovitt is excited about the prospects.

Girls' Soccer returns most of last year's squad with the addition of several underclassmen. The Lady Cards look to build and take the next step in making the state playoffs. Brie Windust, in her second year as head coach, is looking forward to pushing these young women to the next level. Don't be surprised to see post-season play from this group.

Boys' Soccer looks to repeat its state appearance for the 3rd straight year. With a motivated group of seniors and support players, new Head Coach Craig Payton believes his team is ready for the challenges of the new season. The next step for the Cardinals is to crack into the final 8 of the state playoffs; but before that happens, their toughest opponents will lie in league play.

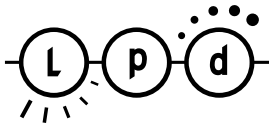
